- transliterating (deciphering/ sounding out the letters/ pronunciation)
- translating (understanding meaning of words, parts of words (compounding))
- 3. deeper comprehension; probably writing (which makes good practice FYI; i recommend poetry in your chosen language to handwrite [draw/copy] & transliterate [American English here] letter-by-letter; then sound-out/attempt to translate [comprehend] using available resources/guides)
